## Your Request:

- 1) Is it possible for a medical device company to seek reimbursement for their device regionally through different Integrated Care Boards (ICBs)?
- 2) If yes, can this be done with or without a NICE appraisal?
- 3) If yes, what is the difference in likeliness of getting a product used and sold with or without a NICE appraisal?
- 4) How do you initiate a dialogue with ICBs to provide information about the product and ultimately selling the medical device?
- 5) What requirements do you have for recommending a product for sale in your region?

## **Our Response:**

1-5) Please note that NHS Cheshire & Merseyside ICB became a statutory body on 01 July 2022 and has not established any formal process for which a medical device company could seek reimbursement for their devices regionally at an ICB level. As a result, NHS Cheshire & Merseyside ICB does not hold any of the information you have requested.
