Your Request:

If you have established an Elective Recovery Board (or Elective Care Board) as part of the NHS's elective recovery plan, please could you provide me with:

1. A list of all members of your elective recovery board and their titles 2. All elective recovery board meeting agendas and minutes 3. A register of elective recovery board members' interests. Please make clear when this was last updated.

For context, the NHS England recovery plan published in February 2022 notes that "Elective care boards within each integrated care system (ICS) have been established to bring together local providers, including the independent sector, to agree priorities and solve operational challenges." Our Response:

The NHS body with a statutory duty to submit and therefore deliver the NHS Plan in Cheshire and Merseyside is Cheshire and Merseyside ICB. This means that ultimate decision making, responsibility and accountability sits with the ICB, which includes elective recovery.

However, in delivering elective recovery it is necessary for the ICB to work with the NHS Trusts and Foundation Trusts within Cheshire and Merseyside. Supplementing and enacting any individual Trust decision making the acute and specialist Trusts within Cheshire and Merseyside coordinate through the Cheshire and Merseyside Acute and Specialist Trust (CMAST) provider collaborative. CMAST Leadership Board is made up of the Trust Chief Executives of each of these Trusts. They together with the ICB represent decisions makers, as applicable, with regards to elective recovery.
