2) Does the NHS hold patient medical records from this practice for 1954? If not, are patient medical records from 1954 held anywhere?

3) I specifically would like to view medical records for xxx

4) What was the recommended prescribed treatment and medication for German Measles (Rubella) in 1954?

5) Any other information you can provide regarding the above would be gratefully received.

Our Response:

Unfortunately, NHS Cheshire & Merseyside ICB as an organisation does not hold any of the above information you have requested or copies of GP records.

For information, the NHS Records Management Code of Practice 2021 (<u>https://transform.england.nhs.uk/media/documents/NHSX_Records_Management_CoP_V7.pdf</u>) [page 51] states that GP Patient records for deceased patients have a retention period of 10 years, following which they are reviewed and destroyed if no longer required.

You may therefore wish to enquire with the last GP Practice that xxx was registered with, to see what GP records they may hold and whether this includes any historic records dating back to 1954.
